We are concerned with the critical shortage of qualified ASL interpreters in Canada and are offering bursaries to assist Canadian and permanent residence aspiring to become ASL interpreters.

The 2011-2012 bursary amount is \$1000.00 CDN per student. Students must be enrolled for their second year or third year of studies to qualify.

All applications and materials required as stated below MUST BE RETURNED TO Helene Mackenzie Trust Fund by Friday July 22, 2011.

The application consists of seven parts:

1. General information to be completed by the student.
2. Financial information; to be completed by the Financial Aid Director of the College or University.
3. Two letters of recommendation, preferably work or volunteer related, one from a deaf individual that is not a family member
4. Provide a 10-minute DVD, showing the student's signing skills.

5. Complete a one-page essay explaining your personal goals and objectives.
6. Provide a resume showing work and volunteer experience, including field-related involvement.
7. Provide most recent transcript of academic marks or a grade report signed by your co-ordinator.
